### CLEARANCE

To be eligible to participate in any practice or tryout, all students must be cleared through the Athletic Office beginning the week of August 7, Monday – Friday, 8AM to 3PM in the Athletic Office and must be completed **before Monday, August 14**. Clearance is not required to attend camps that are being held the week of August 8<sup>th</sup>. Clearance requires the following items to be completed (a more detailed information sheet was mailed out with report cards and to incoming Freshmen in June):

- Current Athletic Emergency Information & Athletic Risk Warning & Travel Release Information forms – signed.
- A current physical – all Freshmen, Juniors and transfer students are required to have a current physical.
- Paid Participation Fee (see below)

### PARTICIPATION FEE

The paid **participation fee** of \$175.00 needs to be paid **before Monday, August 14**. Participation fee for students that qualify for the free lunch program is \$43.75. Students that qualify for reduced lunch must pay \$87.50. If payment is a hardship, please contact the Athletic Director to make other arrangements. If the student is trying out for a sport in which cuts might be made (volleyball or soccer), a refund will be issued if they do not make a team. Football, Water Polo and Cross Country are no-cut Fall sports. Participation fees may be redirected if a student is released and wants to transfer to one of those programs. Payment may be made to the bookkeeper or paid online but **the clearance forms must go to the Athletic Office**.

## STUDENT LOCKERS

Freshmen are assigned lockers. The locker assignment and combination are printed on the student schedules that will be distributed the first day of school. Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors who are interested in using a locker can sign up in the cafeteria the first week of school during lunches.

## TEXTBOOKS

Distribution is by class. Teachers will take their classes to the textbook depository to check out textbooks once school begins.
