Superintendent Perera said a few words

**Review September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Meeting Minutes:** McKay Larrabee asked the committee to review the minutes from the last meeting. There were no changes suggested. Bruce Schmidt asked If school numbers of free and reduced lunches change dramatically does it change the funding or special grants? James Hiu said, yes, that is accurate.

Bruce Schmidt asked when were the numbers collected? McKay said October 2018.

Drake Shelton asked if the goal is to reduce the affected students? McKay recommends that is the number to pay attention to.

West Gresham Elementary School:

- Changes to East Gresham Elementary School:
  - Area north and east of Walters Hill (including Walters Hill)
  - Area east of NW Wallula Ave changes
- Changes to North Gresham Elementary School:
  - Area east of NW Birdsdale Ave, north of NW 5<sup>th</sup> St, and west of NW Wallula Ave

North Gresham Elementary School:

- Changes to Hollydale Elementary School:
  - Area north of NW 1<sup>st</sup> Dr and W Powell Blvd
  - Area south of NW 5<sup>th</sup> St
- Changes to Highland Elementary School:
  - Area east of NW Civic Dr
  - Area south of NW Burnside Rd

Highland Elementary School:

- Changes to East Gresham Elementary School:
  - Area south of NW Burnside Rd
- Changes to North Gresham Elementary School:
  - Community surrounding SE Morrison Ter

#### East Gresham Elementary School:

- Changes to Hogan Cedars Elementary School:
  - Area south of Springwater Corridor
  - Area southeast of SE Regner Rd

#### Hogan Cedars Elementary School:

- Changes to Highland Elementary School:
  - Area north of NE Burnside Rd
- Changes to Hall Elementary School:
  - Area southwest of NE Burnside Rd
  - Area north of SE 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> St
- Changes to Deep Creek/Damascus:
  - Area north of SE Kingswood Way
  - Area surrounding Hide-A-Way, SE Rugg Rd, and SE 267<sup>th</sup> Ave

#### Powell Valley Elementary School:

- Changes to Hall Elementary School:
  - Area west of NE 257<sup>th</sup> Dr

#### Kelly Creek Elementary School:

- Changes to Hall Elementary School:
  - Area north of E Powell Blvd
- Changes to East Orient Elementary School:
  - Area south of SE Hillyard Rd

#### East Orient Elementary School:

- Changes to Kelly Creek Elementary School:
  - Area north of SE Welch Rd
- Changes to Deep Creek/Damascus:
  - Area west of Hwy 26

#### Middle Schools

- Middle school boundaries follow elementary school boundaries so the feeder path remains relatively untouched:
  - Clear Creek Middle School is comprised of:
    - North Gresham Elementary
    - Highland Elementary
    - Northern half of Hollydale Elementary (north of Springwater Corridor)
  - Dexter McCarty Middle School is comprised of:
    - Southern half of Hollydale Elementary (south of Springwater Corridor)
    - East Gresham Elementary
    - West half of Hogan Cedars Elementary (west of but not including SE 252<sup>nd</sup> Ave)
  - Gordan Russel Middle School is comprised of:
    - Hall Elementary
    - Powell Valley Elementary
    - Kelly Creek Elementary
  - West Orient Middle School is comprised of:
    - East Orient Elementary

- East half of Hogan Cedars Elementary (east of and including SE 252<sup>nd</sup> Ave)

**Breakout Groups:** Committee broke out into two groups. GHS feeder schools went into another room to review maps while Barlow feeder group stayed to review maps in library.

Bella vista being split. Currently goes to west. Would be split into three elementary schools. Proposal is to limit it to two schools. Dividing line is Birdsdale.
