## EMERGENCY DRILLS

Next Wednesday students will participate in a building safety drill. Fire, earthquake, Hold, Secure, and Lockdown drills are held regularly to teach students the safest way to respond to emergencies. Specific instructions on evacuating the building are posted in each classroom. In case of a catastrophic emergency, students will be cared for at school, medical conditions permitting, until released to a parent or responsible adult.

## 8th GRADE FAMILIES

If you think your student may be going to a different high school other than Sam Barlow next year, please have your student come into the counseling office. Our Counseling department can help them transfer or register for their new high school.

## CELL PHONE POLICY

**Students may not make or receive calls (or text messages) on a cell phone during the school day.** Prior to entering the school, or once the 3:35 p.m. bell rings, cell phone use is permitted. All devices are to be **stored securely in their locker** during the school day. If a cell phone is used (including texting) by a student, heard ringing, or is visible during the school day, the cell phone or other electronic device will be confiscated.

**1st Offense** - Student pick up at the end of the day in the office

**2nd Offense** - Parent pick up in the office

**3rd Offense** - Parent/Student meeting with administration

Failure to follow cell phone policy may result in the student not being able to bring a cell phone to school. Again, the possession

of any valuable item is discouraged, and the risk of loss or theft is entirely the responsibility of the student.

## Parent Requests For IN-DISTRICT Transfers

**Accepted March 1-31, 2022 \* Deadline is March 31, 2022**

The Gresham-Barlow School District will accept in-district transfer requests for the 2022-2023 school year during the month of March only.

If you live within the Gresham-Barlow district and want your child to attend a Gresham-Barlow school outside of your attendance area, you need to request an in-district transfer. If your student currently has an in-district transfer and is moving from elementary to middle or middle to high, please submit a new request.

A digital transfer request form will be available on the Transfers section of the district [website](#). The link to this form can also be emailed to you directly if you request it from any GBSD school or district office. Forms must be submitted by March 31, 2022.

You will be notified in writing after review of all requests. Please note: kindergarten and first grade requests may not be decided upon until late summer after elementary registration. For further information, contact the Gresham-Barlow School District Office at 503-261-4575.

## AFTER SCHOOL ATHLETIC SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

We are pleased with the parent and student support provided at our after-school games. When it comes to maintaining a game environment that is supportive of athletes and comfortable for all spectators, there are a few guidelines that Russell students should keep in mind.

While attending an athletic event, student spectators need to respect the other spectators attending the event. Movement in and out of the gymnasiums should be restricted to quarter, half, and between game breaks. The doors leading to the hallway are the only doors available for entry and exit. DO NOT use the doors that lead to the football field. These are emergency exits only.

Students attending after school events are expected to be spectators in the stands. Students are not to be roaming around the hallway or areas outside of the gymnasium. These areas, including the covered play area, are off-limits to student activities during our games. Skateboarding and riding bicycles are also prohibited in these areas when after school events are taking place.

Again, we appreciate student spectators at our after-school athletic events. We expect our spectators to behave in a manner respectful of athletes and other spectators. Students and spectators unable to follow our guidelines will be removed from the event and restricted from after-school activities.
