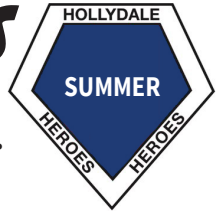

SNAP Benefits Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program



SNAP debit cards can now be used to order food online through Amazon and Walmart for home delivery. Please note that there are delivery fees, which SNAP benefits cannot pay for.

To apply for SNAP benefits:

- Complete an **online SNAP application** at: <https://apps.state.or.us/connect/>
- Visit an Oregon Department of Human Services SNAP office and fill out a paper or online application in person. The nearest office is 11826 NE Glisan Street. Call ahead 971-673-0909.
- Contact Multnomah County SNAP Enrollment Specialist and set up an appointment, any time of the week at 503-320-6658 or 503-928-9689.

Multnomah County Restriction on Evictions:

Multnomah County residents cannot be evicted for not paying rent during the entire time the county and city are under a state of emergency. Rent owed to a landlord will continue to accrue during the state of emergency, but without late fees. There will be a six-month repayment grace period, which will begin as soon as the state of emergency ends. As of right now, this is in effect until **July 9**. Renters must notify their landlords the day before rent is due.

Home Forward works with community agencies to provide hotel vouchers, rent support, help with evictions and housing support for people at risk for homelessness.
