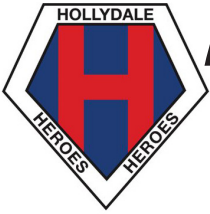

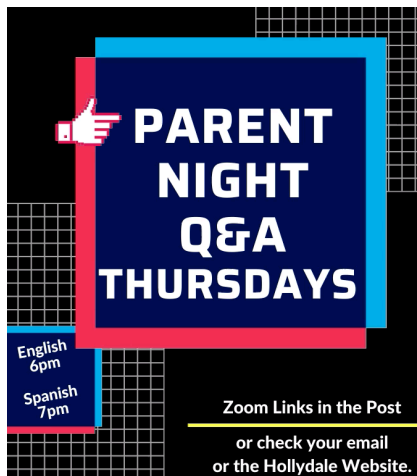

### How to Update Chrome on a Chromebook

**PLEASE NOTE:** This link contains both textual instructions as well as an interactive how-to video for the update.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Start with the Check for updates yourself section. After the patch downloads you will get a RESTART YOUR CHROMEBOOK message, (it may take a minute or two after you hit the 100% download to receive the message). You can click that message or just shutdown and restart.

**IMPORTANT:** The user performing the upgrade should go to SeeSaw and click a MEET link immediately. If this is a student account, they should get a message that says they can't start a MEET. But they should not be stuck with an error going from SeeSaw to MEET.

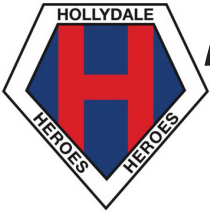

### Immunizations

Parent notification letters will be mailed mid October if your child needs to have their immunizations updated. Even though we are distance learning at this time, all immunizations need to be kept up-to-date.
