



## Gresham High Super Fan Expectations

*Student fans at Gresham High School have a responsibility to: be supportive, loud, and enthusiastic, but also to be respectful, encouraging and appropriate. Below are do's and don'ts of being a Gresham High School Superfan that will help make Gresham a welcome environment for all spectators and participants.*

**Reminder:** Face Coverings are required (over the mouth and nose) while indoors at all home and away games.

### Do:

- Sit/Stand in the GHS Student Section according to signage
- Cheer for the Gophers
- Be loud
- Stand between rows of bleachers during the game
- Participate in positive chants
- Participate in chants led by cheerleaders
- Dress along with a student leadership-created theme
- Remain in the main or aux gyms other than to use the restroom or visit concessions
- Show respect for officials
- Show respect for opponents and fans from an opponent's school
- Show respect for injured players
- Leave the gym within ten minutes from the end of the game

### Don't:

- Yell or chant at an opposing player or coach by name or number, etc.
- Yell or chant at a referee
- Participate in negative chants or booing
- Use profane language
- Bring signs or Fatheads larger than 8.5"x11"
- Bring artificial noisemakers
- Sit in the stairway
- Hang out in the commons outside of the gym
- Shoot baskets or hang out in the gym after the game
