

Oregon Ballot Measure 43

Also known as the "Teen Abortion Notification Initiative," was on the November 7, 2006 ballot in Oregon as an initiated state statute. It was **defeated**.

Measure 43, if it had been approved, would have required the medical provider give 48-hour notice to an un-emancipated minor's parents before **providing an abortion**. The initiative applied to girls 15, 16, and 17 years old, as current law already required parental permission for girls under 15 to have an abortion.
