

Health Game Assignment

Create a health game that is both fun and educational. Games come in a variety of formats. Some types are: board games, quiz games, interactive games and card games. Use games that have already been invented as a basis for your game or combine elements from a few games for a unique game. You can also invent a new game.

Games need to incorporate accurate health information questions as a basis for the game. You also need to create a clear set of rules to guide players through game play. Questions/facts can come from all areas related to health. All questions should however fit into one of the nine areas of health as identified by the National Health Education Standards. Those areas are:

Mental and Emotional health
Violence and Suicide
Sexuality Education
Substance Use and Abuse
Disease Prevention
Safety and First Aid
Environmental Health
Nutrition
Fitness

Can be done in groups of three or smaller.

On the due date you will present your game and will have the opportunity to play other games created by your classmates.
