### **After School Activity Bus**

### **Multnomah County Library Live Homework Help**

Multnomah County Library offers students live tutor assistance via their Live Homework Help System at <https://multcolib.org/resource/live-homework-help-tutor.com> Students will need to have a Multnomah County Library card to access this service. Students can go to a Multnomah County Library branch to obtain a library card or online; even students living outside of Multnomah County can get a library card. This service offers tutoring in Math, Language Arts, Science and Social Studies and tutors can proofread writing assignments. Live Homework Help is available daily from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. in English, Spanish and Vietnamese.
